Rules of Eligibility

1. Scholarship applicant is a graduating senior from Oroville High School, Oroville, Wa. You must be enrolled full time your senior year. Running Start students are included.
2. Applicant must be in good academic standing planning to attend a college, vocational, or technical school.
3. Scholarships will not be awarded to foreign exchange students, home schooled students or out of district students.
4. Answer each question thoroughly and check for content. Each question is scored.
5. Attach your current OHS transcript. It is required.
6. Include two letters of recommendation for extra bonus points.
7. Typed applications are preferred, however, applications neatly written in ink are acceptable.
8. Incomplete or illegible applications will be discarded.
9. Include a nice 3"x 5" graduation photo of yourself on photo paper.
10. This application MUST be signed by the applicant.
11. A parent or guardian MUST also sign this application if you are under age 18.
12. Late, emailed, or hand delivered applications will not be accepted.
